

Introduction to Public Health Practice

Workshop Description: *Introduction to Public Health Practice* is a full-day training that provides a historical perspective on public health accomplishments, offers a brief overview of current trends and emerging issues in public health, and reviews the scientific disciplines that guide public health practice. Additionally, this training will identify organizations at the local, state and national level that comprise the public health system and will explore programs, policies and practices within the framework of the 10 Essential Public Health Services.
